“Behold, I have created the smith who blows on the fire of coals and who produces a weapon for its purpose; and I have created the devastator to destroy. But no weapon that is formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue that shall rise against you in judgment you shall show to be in the wrong. This [peace, righteousness, security, triumph over opposition] is the heritage of the servants of the Lord [those in whom the ideal Servant of the Lord is reproduced]; this is the righteousness or the vindication which they obtain from Me [this is that which I impart to them as their justification], says the Lord.” Isaiah 54:16-17 The Amplified Bible, AMP

I love the above scripture...especially ***“no weapon that is formed against you shall prosper.”*** I have stood on this scripture many times and have had tremendous victory in my life from this truth. Imagine, ***“no weapon formed against us shall prosper!”*** That means if you are in a battle with your ex-husband or anyone else for that matter and they are creating an adversarial situation for you, **it will not prosper!**

The adversarial situation may get formed. It may try to manifest and come upon you. But in the end, it will not prosper!

I can attest to this. I have personally experienced victory by standing on this promise.

Unfortunately, my ex-husband tried everything in his power to not have to pay support amongst other things and the battle continued for a very long time. There were times that it didn't look well for me, or our children and I did battle with hopelessness. But in the end, the children and I had victory. The weapons he was forming to pull me down personally and financially and to take from his children did not prosper.

There were lies he said about me that were vulgar; so vulgar that I wouldn't even allow my Attorney to respond. I left it in the Lord's hand for vindication. I had no idea what the impact would be on me from it, but I knew that I had to stand on ***“no weapon formed against me would prosper.”*** And it proved true.

Over the years my ex knew how to push my emotional buttons. When he clearly succeeded and I was an emotional mess, very calmly he would look at me and say, *“look at you, you are crazy.”* Boy did that push me into a further emotional state. But one day he said it to me again. But this time was different. Something rose in me and with the power of the Holy Spirit I literally was in his face with not a bit of fear inside me and I said ***“NO weapon formed against me will prosper. And every tongue that rises against me my God will condemn. And I ask that in the Name of Jesus, every curse that you are speaking against me now my God will take those curses, turn them around and bless you!”*** I then walked away.

Remember ***“the Word is powerful and sharper than a two-edged sword.”*** Hebrews 4:12. *The Lord gave you one side of the sword when He spoke the Word. Now you speak the same Word and get the other side of the sword. Now your sword is powerful.*
